

What is QIRN4?

The End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Program extends Medicare coverage to all Medicare eligible individuals with ESRD who require dialysis or transplantation to sustain life.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) contracts with ESRD Networks to serve as both a monitoring agency and as a bridge between the federal government, ESRD patients and providers. ESRD Networks provide an effective way for patients and health care providers to work together to ensure that the best possible ESRD services are provided.

ESRD Networks are made up of the following volunteer committees: the Medical Review Board, the Board of Directors and a Patient Advisory Committee. Each committee is made up of professionals and patients.

Quality Insights Renal Network 4 (QIRN4) is the ESRD Network for Pennsylvania and Delaware. QIRN4 is one of 18 ESRD Networks that:

- Promote quality improvement
- Promote rehabilitation and ESRD education
- Interact with ESRD patients and providers
- Collect and analyze data
- Work with other agencies
- Review and investigate patient complaints and grievances about the quality of care provided by dialysis and transplant facilities
- Provide patient and professional educational resources
