



I am New to ESRD: What is a CMS 2728 form? And Why should I sign it?

What is the CMS 2728 form?

It is a document confirming that you are a patient with End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) on chronic dialysis and adds you to a national ESRD registry.

When is this form done?

When you have a confirmed diagnosis of ESRD and receive chronic dialysis treatment(s) or first kidney transplant.

How long does my dialysis center or transplant hospital have to complete this form?

- 1. 45 days from my first chronic outpatient dialysis treatment OR
- 2. 45 days from the date of my transplant if I was not on dialysis

Why should I sign my CMS 2728 form?

- 1. Signing the form establishes your first date of chronic dialysis
 - a. Starts the clock for you to claim ESRD Medicare benefits
 - b. Starts the wait time for transplant
- 2. A signed form is
 - Used in applying for Social Security Disability along with other documents; and
 - b. Needed when you travel or transfer to other dialysis units
