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## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The 2020 Gainful Employment quality improvement activity (QIA) will focus on interventions to support the gainful employment of individuals with ESRD.

### Project Timeframe

January 1, 2020 – September 30, 2020

### Project Goals

- 95% of patients will be screened for VR and/or employment network (EN) services
- 50% of patients will be referred for VR/EN services, including 10 patients
- between the ages 55-64
- 1% of patients will be receiving VR/EN services
- At least one Facility Patient Representative will be recruited as QIA support to facility staff

### Conditions for Coverage

(i) Standard: Relationship with the ESRD Network. The governing body receives and acts upon recommendations from the ESRD network. The dialysis facility must cooperate with the ESRD network designated for its geographic area, in fulfilling the terms of the Network’s current statement of work. Each facility must participate in ESRD Network activities and pursue Network goals.

## GAINFUL EMPLOYMENT QIA GLOSSARY

(in alphabetical order)

Acronym or Term	Description
<b>CfC</b>	<b>Conditions for Coverage</b> - Federal regulations put forth by CMS that are the minimum health and safety rules that all Medicare and Medicaid participating dialysis facilities must meet
<b>CMS</b>	<b>Centers for Medicare &amp; Medicaid Services</b>
<b>CW</b>	<b>CROWNWeb</b> - A web-based data-collection system that allow Medicare-certified dialysis facilities to submit facility and patient data to CMS
<b>EN</b>	<b>Employment Network</b>
<b>ENGAGE</b>	A patient engagement framework that focuses on engagement at the patient-, facility-, and governance-level
<b>Facility Patient Representative</b>	A past or current dialysis patient or family member of a patient who will act as a link between patients and facility staff
<b>LAN</b>	<b>Learning and Action Network</b>
<b>Patient Engagement</b>	A combination of patient knowledge, skills, ability and willingness to manage his/her own health and care
<b>PDSA</b>	<b>Plan, Do, Study, Act</b>
<b>PHFPQ</b>	<b>Population Health Focused Pilot QIA</b>
<b>QIA</b>	<b>Quality Improvement Activity</b>
<b>QAPI</b>	<b>Quality Assurance and Performance Improvement</b>
<b>RCA</b>	<b>Root Cause Analysis</b>
<b>SSDI</b>	<b>Social Security Disability Insurance</b> - Provides benefits to disabled or blind persons who are “insured” by workers’ contributions to the Social Security trust fund
<b>SSI</b>	<b>Supplemental Security Income</b> - A program that makes cash assistance payments to aged, blind, and disabled persons who have limited income and resources
<b>Ticket to Work</b>	A free and voluntary Social Security program that supports career development for SSDI beneficiaries age 18 through 64 who want to work
<b>TWP</b>	<b>Trial Work Period</b>
<b>VR</b>	<b>Vocational Rehabilitation</b>
