- 1. Identify and provide learning opportunities in varying:

 - c. Settings
 - > Home
 - Dialysis unit

- 2. Assess patient's perception of care and quality of life at initiation of dialysis with periodic reevaluation and/or at the end of each treatment.

- 3. Develop qualitative assessment tool that is based in Story Theory.*
- 4. Questions that could be asked by health care professionals include:
 - a. Tell me about the challenges you are facing as you begin dialysis.
 - b. What is most important to you right now?
 - c. Can you think of a past challenge or "difficult time" that you "got through"? Tell me about that time what helped you get through it?
 - d. Tell me about your future hopes and dreams.
- 5. Questions that could be asked by the dialysis technician:
 - a. Can you tell me what is most important to you right now?
 - b. Is there anything I should know about you that you have not already told me?
