BEST PRACTICE 3

Educate patients to improve their understanding of kidney disease—including dialysis, nutrition, health promotion, modality options, co-morbidities and other related health matters—to empower them to make decisions and choices about their care.

HOW DO YOU ACHIEVE THIS BEST PRACTICE?

- 1 Educate patients to improve understanding of kidney disease, including renal replacement options, treatment of co-morbidities, and health promotion strategies that enhance self-efficacy of taking an active role in making decisions about their care. Improve communication with patient who has limited health literacy.
 - a. Talk slowly.
 - b. Use non-medical language.
 - c. Limit information to 2 to 3 key points and repeat the points.
 - d. Use "Teach Back" method. Using simple language, teach the patient and have the patient or caregiver repeat what was said.
 - e. Encourage questions.
- 2. Identify and provide learning opportunities in varying:
 - a. Format
 - Written
 - Live
 - Telephonic
 - b. Delivery vehicles
 - Telephonic
 - Audio
 - Computer-based
 - Web-based
 - Radio
 - c. Settings
 - Home
 - Dialysis unit
 - Hospital
 - Other community providers
- 3. Solicit feedback and questions on all aspects of educational content and delivery and understanding of educational material.
